The Canadian Political Science Association was established in 1913 to encourage and develop political science and to defend the interests of political scientists.

## ELIGIBILITY

If you are a political scientist or a student in political science, or have an interest in the study of politics, you may apply for membership in the Association.

Membership in either of the two categories available (Canadian Political Science Association only, or a joint membership in the Canadian Political Science Association and the Société québécoise de science politique) includes a subscription to the *Canadian Journal of Political Science*. A joint membership also includes a subscription to the Société's *Politique et Sociétés*. There are two levels of membership fees in each category. Income level stated refers to gross annual income (before taxes).
