Membership Guidelines for CPSA Conference Paper-givers, Poster and Three Minute Thesis Presenters

-Approved on 05.06.04; Amended on 06.12.14, 04.06.15, 18.09.15 and 7.10.16

The CPSA Board of Directors resolved that:

Paper-givers, poster and three minute thesis presenters in our annual Programme (with the exception of specially invited guests) must be members of the association.

Potential paper-givers, poster and three minute thesis presenters who are nonmembers be invited to join the Association and that if, by the early registration deadline set by Congress and/or CPSA, they have not done so, see their presentation removed from the programme within one week by the Programme Committee Chair.

The following terms apply:

1) Specially invited guests of the programme committee will be exempt from the membership requirement.

2) All Canadian political scientists in Canada must become members of the CPSA.

3) Presenters not residing in Canada who can provide confirmation of a membership in their national association will be exempt from the membership requirement. Coauthors, not residing in Canada, and not attending the meetings, are exempt from the membership requirement.

4) For multiple authored papers, all Canadian political scientists must become members. If all or some co-authors are foreigners or members of other scholarly disciplines, guideline 3 will be followed.
