CPSA CONFERENCE

MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES FOR

PAPER-GIVERS, POSTER AND THREE MINUTE THESIS PRESENTERS

-Approved on 05.06.04; Amended on 06.12.14, 04.06.15, 18.09.15 and 7.10.16-

The CPSA Board of Directors resolved that:

1. Paper-givers, poster and three minute thesis presenters (authors) in our annual Programme must be members of the Association.
2. Authors who are Canadian political scientists residing in Canada, whether attending the conference or not, must become members of the CPSA.
3. Authors who are non-members be invited to join the Association and that if, by the early registration deadline set by Congress and/or CPSA, they have not done so, see their presentation removed from the programme within one week by the Programme Committee Chair.
4. The following authors and guests will be exempt from the membership requirement:
 - 4.1 Specially invited guests of the Programme Committee;
 - 4.2 Authors who do not reside in Canada, are attending the conference, and provide confirmation of a membership in their national association.¹
 - 4.3 Authors not residing in Canada and not attending the conference.
 - 4.4 Authors from other scholarly disciplines.
